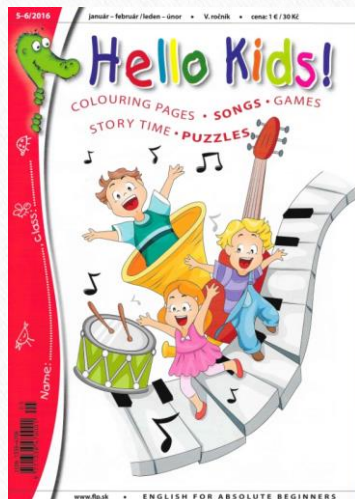

WONDERS OF NATURE

The USA is very big and has wonderful nature. There are so many different things to see that we can't write about them all. Here are four wonders of nature you should know.

Grand Canyon, Arizona

The Grand Canyon was made by the Colorado River. The canyon is 446 kilometres long, which is longer than Slovakia. The canyon is about 1,800 metres deep. The canyon has beautiful colours. About 5 million people visit the canyon every year. Many go hiking¹ or rafting. Some take helicopter flights² to see the canyon. The weather is extreme here, so it can be dangerous.

Mammoth Cave, Kentucky

Mammoth Cave³ is the longest known cave in the world. It is over 650 kilometres long. It's as long as your trip from Bratislava to the sea in Croatia. The cave is called Mammoth Cave because it is so BIG. People lived in this cave thousands of years ago. Now it is home to many animals. Some of them are blind. There are many dripstones⁴. Tourists can walk, sail a boat, or take adrenaline tours in the cave.

The Mississippi River

The famous Mississippi is the largest river in the USA. The Mississippi is simply huge. At its widest point⁵ it is over 11 kilometres wide! It flows through 10 US states and empties into the Gulf of Mexico. It takes a drop of water 90 days to travel down the whole river. People have travelled by the river for centuries. Today it provides⁶ water and electricity to several states. The writer, Mark Twain, made the Mississippi famous in his books.

Yosemite National Park, California

Yosemite National Park is an old national park and is really wild. There are deep forests to wander in, lots of wild animals to see, and rivers to raft. There are rocks good for climbing. Its many waterfalls⁷ are beautiful and the famous. Yosemite Falls is the tallest waterfall in North America. El Capitan and Half Dome are famous monoliths⁸, popular with climbers and base jumpers.

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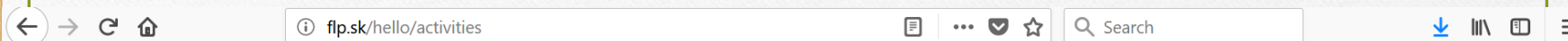

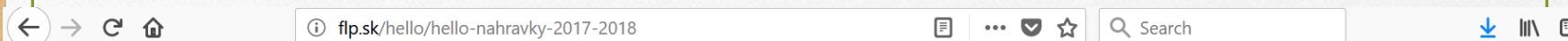
