



Cyclists from all over the world are in the race! The race goes to different places every year, but it always finishes in Paris.

Czech Republic Ice hockey has lots of fans in the Czech Republic. Their men's team was the gold medal winner of the 1998 Olympic Games and they win medals in competitions every year. This country is one of the 'Big Six'. They're the countries with the best ice hockey teams in the world: Canada, the USA, Finland, Russia, Sweden and the Czech Republic.






