




Differences between speaking and writing



Temporary

Instant interaction

Often spontaneous and takes little thought

Mistakes more acceptable

Expressive features (Intonation, stress, etc)

Focus on pronunciation



Permanent

Delayed interaction

Takes more thought and planning

Mistakes not as acceptable

Expressive features (Punctuation, underlining, etc)

Focus on spelling



Why write in class?

- 1. The teacher can be on hand to help.
- 2. The students can help each other.
- 3. An opportunity for peer correction
- 4. Can be communicative and interactive
- 5. Exam practice
- 6. To ensure that students ACTUALLY write
- 7. Can be fun
- 8. Teamwork helps students to develop the SKILL of writing.
