- 1 Suggested answers: Sun, beach, sangria, bulls, flamenco, football, Barcelona, Madrid etc.
- 2 Open answers
- 3 Because he wanted adventure/Because life in his village was boring.
His life was simple but good because he had food, a nice house, a horse and a dog, and friends.
Open answers
Good things: Don Quixote saw Aldonza Lorenzo as a beautiful woman, he tries to be nice to the fine women outside the inn and he tries to help Andrés.
Bad things: He runs at two men outside the inn with his lance, he leaves Andrés with the angry man in the end and he runs and shouts at the rich men.
People generally think he is very strange or interesting.
