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Teaching Notes

- Read the chant to the children (see page 1).
- Draw simple stick figures for the actions and put the **flashcards** on the board as you read. They will help the students learn and remember the sequence of the chant.
- Next, read it again. Invite the children to say *hooray* as you say the chant.
- Ask children to watch the drawings and flashcards that you put on the board as they try to chant (the entire chant) along with you. The drawings will help them remember what to say!
- After they learn it well, chant and march around the room.
- Then, chant and pantomime the actions together. Have fun!
